



FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITIES

Each Silver Regiment member's parent(s) or legal guardian(s) is/are entitled to membership and full voting privileges in the Lake Howell High School Band Parents Association. All parents are encouraged to attend general membership meetings in the Band Room.

Each SR member's parent/guardian will receive the TUG Times, the official newsletter, approximately three times per year; it includes deadlines, dates, phone numbers, and other important information. Parents and students are encouraged to provide and keep current with the BPA any email addresses to receive updates which are sent at least weekly with important dates, times, and information for students and parents.

Parents and students are responsible for keeping the student's financial account current. Annual dues for the year will be \$275 for musicians, \$180 for color guard and \$275 for winter guard. Other assessments (instrument maintenance, special trips, bus charges, breakage fees, etc.) may be assessed to the student's account as needed throughout the year. In addition, it is anticipated that parents and students will participate in various fundraising efforts to make up the balance of the annual budget.

By signing this form, the parent/legal guardian agrees to 1) bring their account current (if applicable) at registration, 2) pay the agreed upon assessment at registration (normally 1/2 of the full assessment, unless prior arrangements are made) and the balance no later than December 1 and 3) participate in fundraising efforts provided by the BPA to help fully fund the band program.

Incomplete or missing forms and/or unpaid dues will result in student restriction of band privileges and participation.
